# Knowledge Organiser: Pattan's Pumpkin

## Key Vocabulary in Art

**Printmaking**- to transfer one mark or image from one surface to another

**Rubbings** - considered the oldest form of printmaking. Rubbing a crayon or pencil over paper while on top of a textured surface

**Texture** - what things are made from and how they feel

**Repeating Patterns** - patterns that repeat again and again

**Collagraph** - a printmaking technique creating a board with a material such as a string stuck to it. Paint or ink is then used to cover the material before printing onto a surface.

**Stamping** - Adding paint or ink to the surface of an object to 'stamp' onto the paper

	Food Tasting	Find a recipe for an Indian dish that you would like to create at home. Follow the instructions and have a tasting session with your family. Remember to get help from an adult and that you will need adult supervision when cooking or preparing food.
	Pumpkin Poems	Can you write a poem about pumpkins? Collect all the things you know about pumpkins and order them into a poem.
	Transporting food	Pick your favourite fresh fruit or vegetable. Find out how it gets from the fields or trees to your house. How many forms of transport are used?
	Forms of transport	How many forms of transport can you think of? Can you put them in order of when they were invented?
	Repeating Patterns	Can you find examples of repeating patterns at home. Maybe you have them on your curtains or wallpaper. Design your own wallpaper using repeating patterns.
	Plants in my garden	Find out which plants are growing in your garden. Draw and label the parts of the plant.
	Food Donation	Have a look through your cupboards for some dried goods that are in date that you are happy to donate to a local food bank or add something to the food bank collection on a trip to the supermarket.
	Rubbings	Can you collect rubbings from a range of textures and surfaces. These could be used to create an autumn picture or a creation of your own!
	Map work	Find India in an atlas/on a globe or using Google Earth. What is the capital city? Can you identify some of the geographical features e.g. mountain ranges, forests, rivers
