	Paper collage	Create a collage in the style of Henri Matisse. Think of an animal or insect you could use for your subject and then use brightly coloured paper to recreate the animal or insect as a collage
	Adaptations	Pick an animal from the Arctic. Draw and label the animal with its adaptations that allow it to survive in a cold climate.
	Route to school	How do you travel to school? Think about how you travel to school. Use a video recorder, smartphone or tablet to record your journey to school.
	Story writing	Write an adventure story set in the Arctic region.
	Eco warrior	Find out ways you can reduce your 'carbon footprint' and try doing them at home – for example, walking or biking, switching off lights and sockets, and recycling and reusing products.
	Poster	What do animals need to survive? How do we keep happy and healthy? Create a poster to promote a happy and healthy lifestyle.
